


Buses

Bus routes **186**, **223**, **H9**, **H10** and **H14** enter the grounds of Northwick Park and St Mark's Hospitals, and routes **182** and **N18** stop a short distance away on Watford Road. Route **186** picks up passengers additionally outside St Mark's Hospital on the Northern perimeter road (bus stop **HW**).

Bus routes **114**, **183** and **H9** stop on Kenton Road, about a 10 minute walk from the hospitals, whilst routes **H9**, **H10**, **H18** and **H19** stop at Northwick Park Station, about five minutes walk.

 Low-floor, wheelchair accessible buses run on all routes.

Tube and rail links

Northwick Park on the Metropolitan line is the nearest Tube station to the hospitals, five minutes walk away. It is also accessible from Northwick Park and St Mark's Hospitals by route **H9**.

Kenton station, for Bakerloo and London Overground services, is accessible from Northwick Park and St Mark's Hospitals by bus routes **223** and **H9**.

Car parking at Northwick Park and St Mark's Hospitals

Parking is available throughout the hospital grounds in car parks 1, 2, 3 and 4; these locations are clearly signposted.

 There are a limited number of disabled spaces that are free to permit holders. These are available for disabled people attending the hospital for healthcare purposes (but not for friends and relatives).

Concessionary rates apply for longer stays. To find out more please contact the parking office adjacent to the Accident and Emergency entrance (or call 020 8869 3803).

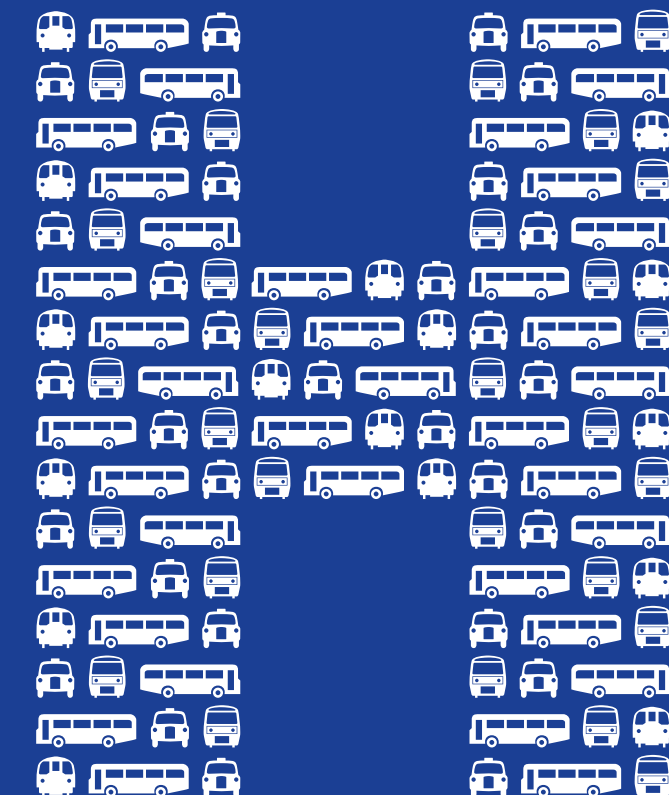

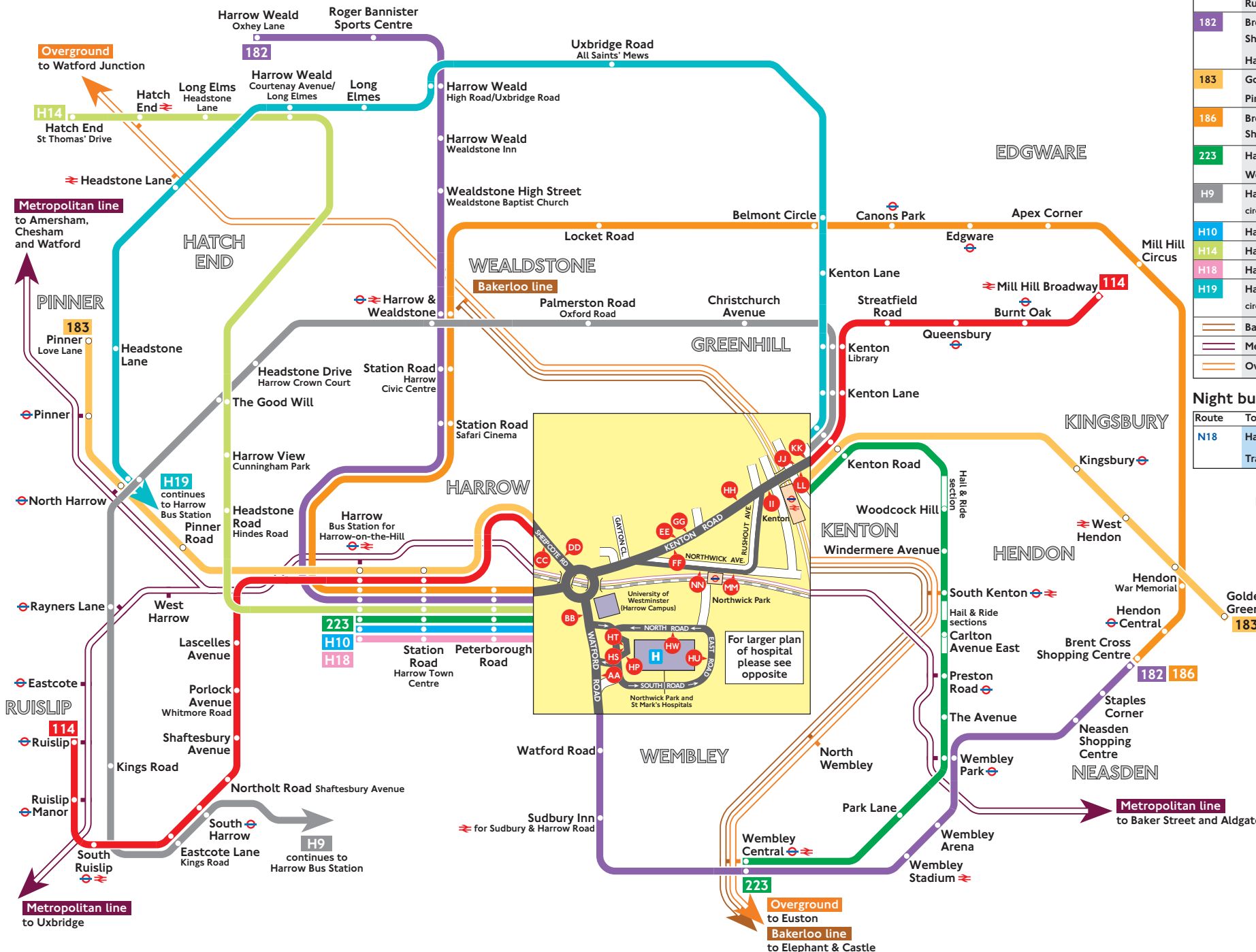
